NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

1.2 The prescriptions of US SAILING will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20 and the Class Rules.

2.2 Boats may be required to display identification (bow) numbers and sponsors

advertising for the duration of the event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.4. These items will be supplied free of charge by the Organizing Authority (OA) at registration.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Etchells Class

3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Rochester Yacht Club by August 16, 2009

3.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:
A late fee of \$95 will be added to any entries received after August 16th 2009

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

4.2 *Class* Etchells \$195.00 (includes Bagals on Sat for three people) Beer every day after races. Cook out on Saturday night

4.3 Additional crew fee \$ 30.00

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration at Rochester Yacht Club

7. VENUE

7.1 Attachment A shows the location of the racing area.

8. THE COURSES

8.1 The courses shall be windward - leeward configuration that will utilize a leeward gate.

9. SCORING

9.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 The Low Point scoring system will be used, RRS Appendix A.

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

11. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus (including snorkels) and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones

12.2 The RC will use VHF radio to communicate to the fleet, including the location of the starting area, countdown to the start, OCS bow/sail numbers, General Recalls and Postponements. Failure to make these broadcasts or failure to hear them shall not constitute grounds for granting redress. This changes RRS 62.1.

13. PRIZES

13.1 The overall winner will be awarded the (still working on this)

13.2 Prizes will be awarded to the top five (5) skippers and crews.

13.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14.2 Skippers and crew will be required to sign waiver of liability during registration.

15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent.

16. Support Boats

Support boats shall register with the race committee prior to the skippers meeting. Support boats shall be given an identifying flag and assigned number. The identifying flag shall be flown at all times during the

regatta, and all boats are required to monitor RC VHF channel (Skippers Meeting) during the regatta.
