- Engine maintenance experience required.

- General maintenance such fiber glassing, replacing rigging and cordage, tuning, maintaining hulls and rigging, recording what work needs to be done and following through. Boat bottom painting, hull faring and waxing, winterizing, prepping for the season.
- Race Committee Boats including (2) 32' Signal boats and (1) 22' Boston Whaler Markset. General maintenance. Painting boat bottoms and gearing up for the season as well as winterizing. Basic engine repairs, oil changes, etc.
- Coach boats (5 13ft whalers, 2 17ft whalers, 3 inflatables) including cleaning, oil changes, general maintenance, bottom painting, winterizing and preparing for season.
