

Class R Boats Race Tomorrow In Trial Meet

Class R boats will have their first work-out of the season tomorrow afternoon when they will race over a new course laid out off Summerville by the Rochester Yacht Club. The Rogue, M. E. S., Mybar, and Safara will line up for this event at 3 o'clock and according to indications a large fleet of power boats will carry members and friends out to see the race.

The race will merely be a practice race and will not count in the season's standing. The first official race will be staged Sunday morning at 10:30 o'clock and on every Sunday following.

Included in the rather elaborate program of Saturday's events are water stunts in the river off the club's boathouse such as out-board motor races, rowing races etc. A dinner dance in the evening will conclude the day's entertainment.

Herbert L. Stone, editor of Yachting, and E. G. Anderson of the Larchmont Yacht Club are the other judges selected.
