









We thank the officers and members of the Rochester Yacht Club for inviting us and we look forward to the fine racing and wonderful hospitality for which the club has long been renowned.



#### A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ROCHESTER YACHT CLUB

Our Club had its beginning in 1877. In that year, thirteen gentlemen organized themselves as Directors of a society, the object being "the encouragement and promotion of Yachting."

A Clubhouse was erected, the first of four, on the beach in Summerville and was formally opened on June 23, 1877. Newspaper accounts reported that a Regatta, open to all Monroe County boats was held in July.

In 1886, Incorporation papers were filed. In that year George H. Newell was Commodore, Matthew Cartwright, Vice Commodore; Charles A. Worts, Secretary; Edmund Occumpaugh, Treasurer and Edward N. Walbridge, Captain.

In 1887, land was cleared on the east bank of the Genesee River. This gave the Club an anchorage and was the beginning of our current basin. That year the roster showed 117 members, 15 Sail Yachts and 8 Steam Yachts.

It is not quite clear as to what happened to the first Clubhouse. Records indicate that it might have been destroyed by fire. So in 1889, the second Clubhouse was constructed on the west bank of the river with 157 members.

In 1902, another move found the Clubhouse back in Summerville, just east of the east pier. It was a three story structure with a large veranda. This building later was to become known as, "Popp's Inn" and survived until the early 1950's.

In 1908 a plan was developed to improve the basin, the area was formerly a swamp. Some work was done in 1909, lockers were added and the first dredging process was started.

During 1917 or there about a Star Fleet was established with interclub racing with The Cleveland Yacht Club.

In 1922 the fourth and current Clubhouse was built on the east bank, just north of the swing bridge. This Clubhouse was substantially remodeled in 1953, again in 1973. It has accommodated many a function in its sixty odd years.

In 1925, the "R" Class came to the Club with a fleet of four boats, they were to become the backbone of the Clubs Racing activities, also in that year, the Club elected to membership, Sir Thomas Lipton, the famous Tea merchant and 5 time challenger for the America's Cup. He presented R.Y.C. with a Trophy that bears his name. We still race for the Cup under L.Y.R.A. and still in "R" boats as the original Deed of Gift called for.

In 1926 the Rochester Junior Yacht Club was started.

In the early 30's it was decided by some of our astute members that we needed a new design for our Dinghy Fleet. At that time we were sailing Cat rigged boats, while the Canadians and British were Sloop rigged. A delegation went to England and commissioned UFF-Fox to design a 14 foot Dinghy. This little craft proved so successful that in 1939 the International 14 Association was formed at R.Y.C. and we became Fleet Number One. In interclub competition, they raced for the Emerson and Douglas Trophies and at R.Y.C. they raced for the Baker and Ford Cups. The 14's went on to become World Famous and to this day are still actively being raced.

For over fifty years, R.Y.C. was the dominating factor in Canada Cup contests. The Cup was won first by R.Y.C.'s "Genesee" in 1899, sailing under Chicago Yacht Clubs Burgee. It came to Rochester in 1903 having been won by "Irondequoit", and was successfully defended until 1954 when it came to an end when R.Y.C.'s "Iskareen" lost to R.C.Y.C.'s "Venture".

1936 was a big year at R.Y.C. In June we sent eight men and three of our new 14 foot Dinghies to Europe. They first raced in Denmark, then Oslo, Norway. Scotland was next, then to Cowes, Isle of Wight, England. They returned home after two months with a basket of Trophies, including the Gold Cup, taken at Cowes. Another triumph that year was bringing the Worlds Star Class Championship to R.Y.C., our first Worlds. In L.Y.R.A. competition, we took the Mabbett and Lipton Cups. To top it off, we went to Chicago and brought home the Richardson Cup. In 1936, R.Y.C. came of age.

In 1939 the first of the Six Meter's arrived on the scene. Over the years they would develop into the greatest interclub racing yet seen on the Lake.

In 1941 news report stated "Now many of the best sixes are on Lake Ontario and it is well on the way to becoming the worlds "Center of the Class"."

In the mid-fifties, we had the North Americans on the Lake with boats from as far away as California. The winner went to Norway at the invitation of the King and Queen. For those who experienced them, there will never be anything to replace the "Sixes" Golden Years.

It was in 1948 that R.Y.C. came into prominence. This was the Rochester Race, the longest fresh water race in the world. In the years of its running, it rated with the Port Hudson and Chicago Mackinac races and with these races formed a Summer Yacht Racing circuit.

It was about 1953 that the Dragon Fleet arrived, at its peak we had eleven boats. The Interclub Trophy was the John Foster Dulles Cup, and today the class is still active.

Through the history of the Club, we have raced custom built boats, rule, built "P"'s & "R"'s, then the Meter boats "8"'s and "6"'s. The 14's, Jolly Boats, Rhodes Bantams, Knarrs, 420's Tempest, Solings, Ensigns, 505's. Lasers and now Windsurfers.

In 1982 we were again to send an R.Y.C. boat to Europe, as we did in 1936. However, this time it was an 8 Meter. "Iroquois" went to Norway and came home a world champion and if that wasn't enough to prove a point, they repeated it in 1983.

Through the years R.Y.C.'s boats have raced off the lake to Chicago in 1899. Then through the years, S.O.R.C. saw the R.Y.C. Burgee in the 60's and 70's, six times in the Bermuda Race, five times in the Chicago Mackinac, and eight times in the Port Huron Mackinac. As for our cruising boats, we currently have two in the Mediterranean.

We can thank our founding fathers for the great history that R.Y.C. has had over the past 100 odd years and our object is still the same as theirs; "The encouragement and promotion of Yachting."

# THE INTERNATIONAL SOLING

#### **HISTORY**

In 1964 the International Yacht Racing Union began a search for a modern 3-man keelboat. An international design competition was held from which three design were selected for testing. The design became reality and at Kiel, Germany in September of 1966 the competition stopped being hypothetical. At the end of eleven races. the choice was narrowed to the Soling or the Shillalah. The Shillalah was larger and faster, but the Soling had very impressive handling characteristics and was less expensive. In November of 1967, the Soling was selected as the new international 3-man keelboat class.

The Soling had shown its potential even before receiving international status. July of 1967 saw the first international regatta in Copenhagen with 17 competitors. In November of 1968, the Soling was further honored with selection for the '72 Olympic Games. At that time there were almost 2000 boats in the class. Progress did not slacken; over forty countries were affiliated with the class by 1973 and over 60 boats com-

peted in the World Championship of 1975.

With beauty, excellent sailing qualities and participation in the Olympic Games of '76, '80 and '84 it is no wonder that the Soling has been selected by some of the world's best sailors.

#### DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

The fin hull and spade rubber make the soling as maneuverable as any board boats. The many below deck mechanical advantages allow ease of adjustment by skipper and crew. She is fast, easily handled and extremely seaworthy in rough conditions. But perhaps the most notable feature of this keelboat is that she will float after filling with water, thus allowing her to be self-rescuing.

The Soling is made of fiberglass and shaped according to class authorized molds. During molding, each hull is checked with a template several times. The center of gravity for hull and keel are established with great accuracy. All of this standardization helps to assure emphasis on the skipper's and crew members' skill.

More than any other Olympic class, the Soling requires steady helmsmanship. As a three man boat, she is ideally suited to those who enjoy teamwork.

#### CLASS ORGANIZATION

The International Soling Association (ISA) is a strong centralized authority overseeing all national Soling associations. Builder must be licensed by the class as suitable for production, and all boats are checked by impartial certified measurers. Uniformity of sails is tightly controlled and the number of sails which can be used for major regattas is restricted.

Those who join are kept well informed by the ISA's "Soling Sailing", which is published four times a year.

Members are not simply competitors, they are friends who enjoy the social aspect of a regatta as true Corinthian Yachtsmen.

#### **SOLING VENUES**

#### ROCHESTER-

The Rochester Yacht Club, on the Southern shore of Lake Ontario, was one of the first and remains one of the most active Soling Clubs in the world with a 15-20 boat fleet which races every weekend from mid-May to October.

Because Rochester is on the south shore of a Great Lake, the prevailing wind of the summer, the weather system Southwesterly (generated on the back of the persistent high above the Atlantic Coast), is following offshore and, therefore, opposes the onshore lake breeze. This frequently means "Two Winds Simultaneously", the Southwester (or Southerly or Southeasterly) near the shore and the Northerly thermal lake breeze offshore. A Northwesterly (or Northerly) weather system wind, althou unopposed, because it is not blowing offshore (no thermal turbulence), tends to be lighter than expected and associated with shifts between it and the lake breeze. After the lake breeze does appear at mid-day at about 20', it gradually increases in velocity (but rarely to more than 10 knots) with the heating of the land. When the weather system wind is Northerly, the lake breeze oscillates significantly, but if the former is Southerly, the lake breeze tends to be steady and separated from the weather system wind by a zone of calm. Thus, Rochester's reputation for light air.

However, frequently the Southwester is strong enough (if forecasted to be 15 knots or more) to dominate the lake breeze and be the only wind apparent. Even then it is strongest and most shifty near shore (near the weather mark) and weakest offshore (near the leeward mark). When the wind is light at the start or the leeward mark, it usually pays to go left (the locals say "Head For The Beach") to gain the advantage of more wind along the port tack layline and to discover the frequent back in the left corner. When the wind is stronger (above 15 knots), the difference in wind velocity is less significant and a velocity veer becomes evident, particularly in the right corner. Of course, these tendencies are assoiciated with oscillations which, if great enough - 10' or more (sometimes 20' at a stroke!) - should be utilized. During a recent firecracker regatta it paid to go left on almost every first beat and to go right on almost every subsequent beat. At least it was unwise to go all the way left after the first beat. Frequently no veer appeared until one reached the starboard tack layline - and it paid, if going right, to go all the way to the layline. A gradual veer (from 250 to 280) with time and with increasing wind velocity was evident during each day but the wind had returned to its original 250' - 260' direction the following morning.






