Bert Harness has purchased a new spar and boom of the flexible type for "Suzette". This is the third boat to be equipped with the flexible rig in the Rochester Fleet.

The first race in the series for the club championship is scheduled to start on May 21st. The seasons racing has been split up into a Saturday and Sunday series with a separate series for the Doyle trophy, commencing August 14. Another series in which the crews will handle the tiller ~~for the Snyder trophy~~ will be held for the Snyder trophy commencing June 19 and running concurrently with the club championship series.
