

L. Y. R. A. Regatta At Belleville To Open Tomorrow

Ontario And Erie Craft To Compete In Events; R Boats Largest Class

Farley's Rogue To Again Stack Up Against Formidable Rival, Kathea, of Watertown—Rochester Club To Have Entries in P Class Races—Rogue Named Wnner in Freeman Cup Race.

More than 50 sailing craft from Lake Ontario and a few from Lake Erie will compete in the annual Lake Yacht Racing Association Regatta which will begin at Belleville, Bay of Quinte, tomorrow and continue through the rest of the week.

Interest centers very largely in the R class and P class races in which Rochester will have several entries. Alloed Lawrence Mabbett's P class Fisher cup challenger will have her first try-out against the boat which will race her in the Toronto cup race in September—probably the Berenice or at any rate one of the six Toronto P boats entered in the Belleville races. The Rochester club also has the P class Olympian entered, the boat that won the Freeman cup last year only to lose it because she did not tow a dingy.

Peck Farley's R class Rogue—winner of the Freeman cup on day and Sunday—will again stack up against her bitter rival the

Kathea of Watertown. The R class will be the largest in the races and will include besides the Rogue and Kathea, William Barrow's Saffara of Rochester, the Huskie of Water town, the Mybar of Rochester, probably the M. E. S. of Rochester, the Nayada of Toronto, and a half dozen others.

Final computation of the time on the Freeman race from Toronto to Presqu' ile shows that Rogue won on corrected time over the big Toronto cutter, by half an hour. The Rogue made a record run of the 70 miles, and Skipper Farley attributes the win very largely to the work of the crew in handling the light canvas. The crew was composed of Bud Little, Clarence Ferris and Ole Carlson.
