Sir Thomas J. Lipton Trophy for class "R" Boats on Take Ontario.

WHEREAS, Sir Thomas J. Lipton, Baronet of Osage, Southgate, England has presented to the Rochester Yacht Club, of which club he has been an honorary member for many years, a suitably designed Trophy for the "R" Class on Lake Ontario, and to quote from his presentation letter: \_ "to contribute to the encouragement of the glorious and health giving sport of yachting".

- 1. This cup shall be known as the Sir Thomas J. Lipton Permanent Trophy for Class "R" Boats in the "20 rating class", on Lake Ontario.
