We do, however, wish to prevent the use of our club by those who are not entitled to do so. Your co-operation to this end is earnestly solicited.

Members may procure extra keys for members of their families who are allowed the privileges of the Club. These keys may be had for twenty-five cents each by application to the Manager at the Club Office.

Those who come to the Club at the invitation of Members or who have business to transact for or with Members or Officers of the Club, may gain admission by ringing the bell at the gate. There is suitable notice to this effect on the gate.
