





# CRUISING FLEET






















The Dragon Fleet hosted a twoweek marathon regatta which started the fourth of July weekend with the Great Lakes Championships. About 17 boats were entered, coming from Cleveland to Ottawa.

Immediately following the Great Lakes Championships the Dragon Fleet took off on the Snap Dragon Regatta — a series of four races around the lake, first being Rochester to Sodus, second was Sodus to Oswego, the third was Oswego to Henderson, and the final leg was Henderson to Kingston.

The Klaus Baess Trophy was awarded to Howard Low for best overall racing record throughout the entire season.

This year the Dragons will bring in the North American Championships the first week of September for another exciting series.





The Soling Fleet, strong as ever, was honored with the most active sailing schedule in North America!

The Firecracker Regatta was held over the Fourth of July weekend with approximately 37 Solings entered. The weather was quite predictable for the weekend — "unpredictable." The Regatta started without wind and ended with about a 20 mph westerly blow! 10 miles of racing over the side of a Soling!



This year, 1981, the Soling Fleet, already 20 strong, will host the Firecracker regatta over the fourth of July with 40 Solings expected to enter.








The Great Lakes Championships for J/24's was held over Labor Day Weekend and 35 boats were entered for this extravaganza! The fleet had quite a cross section (one crew drove 24 hours straight from Nova Scotia.) There were those who wanted serious racing and then those who wanted serious partying: All were in rare form!

The regatta was won by Kirk Reynold's Cruel Shoes, skippered by Norm Freeman. With the victory also came an invitation to the World Championship in San Remo, Italy, where Norm, Kirk and the rest of the crew finished second to 1976 Silver Medalist, John Kolius.

Tom Roth was awarded the Glenn F. Litchfield Memorial Trophy for best overall in the Saturday and Sunday series. The Innisfree Trophy for best overall in the Sunday series was awarded to Frank Shumway, while Bob Castle was awarded the Seneca Trophy for best overall in the Saturday series.

This year the J/24 fleet has doubled in size to about 20 boats. The fleet will host the North American Championships, August 20-24, with approximately 75 boats in attendance.











LADIES RACING FLEET








The 1980 Junior Racing Program continued with many instructional programs. Renee Bianco was awarded the Katie Grey Trophy for the female skipper with the best sailing record for the season. The Jonathan H. Heinrich Memorial Trophy was awarded to Marc Fischer for the skipper with the best racing record. Of particular note for the Junior Yacht Club was the award given to member Robert Fischer — the Clifton H. Baker Memorial Trophy. This award is given to the skipper or crew member under the age of 25 who displays the greatest improvement in sailing ability during the racing season.

The 1981 program will be filled with racing which includes a series of 20 races beginning June 6th — two races a day for 10 weeks with flags awarded.







Once again it was an exciting and active year around the Great Lakes.

Overall, 144 boats were entered in the Freeman and Lake Yacht Racing Association events. The Freeman Cup attracted the greatest number of boats — 120! The 131 mile race course began at Port Credit on August 3 and finished at Hamilton, Ontario.

Three days of LYRA course racing was hosted by the Royal Hamilton Yacht Club with 112 boats participating. This was followed by the Centennial Race which ran 30 miles from Hamilton to Toronto.


The Lake Ontario International Race followed a 218 mile course beginning in Toronto and ending in Rochester.

Another accomplishment which gave RYC great pride was the award of Boat of the Year Division III to Wild Card!


Rochester Yacht Club was proud to have its members active and victorious in many of the major races throughout the Great Lakes.


