As requested, this letter provides professional design services for fees on this project.

It is my understanding that at this time, you are seeking services sufficient to apply for site plan approval of the project. As a side benefit, you would like sufficient documentation to obtain at least preliminary construction costing.

We anticipate you will require an accurate overall site plan, building plans and building elevations. In addition, an outline specifications giving, in general terms, information on materials selection is advisable.

At this time, it is premature to expend monies for subsurface information although as a part of future phases this work will have to be done. We do strongly suggest a site survey be obtained, at least of the clubhouse office and north areas of the site. A survey will be expected by the approval agencies and even if the project not proceed, will prove to be an asset to the Club. Current available survey data is inadequate for even design purposes.
