This is in regard to the fitting out of the OLYMPIAN, as well as the ALLOEDE, for a series of trial races for the purpose of selecting the fastest P Class yacht available to back up our challenge for the Fisher Cup. The opinion has been expressed by some that the OLYMPIAN should be fitted out as a trial horse for the ALLOEDE and it is also quite possible that she might prove the faster boat and, if so, should be selected as the actual challenger.

The money for equipping boats for this purpose must be raised by subscription and it is thought that a large enough sum might be obtained to take care of both boats. The entire matter will be put up to the members at the March 28th meeting for their consideration and decision.
