

Local Boatman Is Selected To Attend Meeting

Lorenzo G. Mabbett, owner, and skipper of the Rochester Yacht Club sloop, *Alloede*, has been chosen as one of the Lake Ontario yachtsmen to attend the meeting of the Lake Yacht Racing Union at its annual meeting at Toronto Saturday. Other representatives of the Lake Yacht Racing Association of Lake Ontario are George Gooderham and Thomas Wade both of the Royal Canadian Yacht Club of Toronto. The union is the high court of sailing on the lakes and will be attended by representatives of the Lake Erie and Lake Michigan associations.

Various changes in rules of yacht racing will be discussed. Sections of amendments brought up at the union's meeting last fall at Hamilton will also be debated. Of highest importance is the amendment forbidding boats with permanently curved masts built after November 15, 1924, from entering races. The proposal is a direct blow to the marconi rig and is expected to meet with great favor with the Canadian delegates.
