

NOTICE OF RACE

Event Name: Sunset House Memorial Hospice Regatta

Date: August 19-20, 2017

Location: Rochester, New York

Host Clubs: Rochester Yacht Club & Genesee Yacht Club

Events: The Rochester Memorial Hospice Regatta consist of one day of course racing, and one day of optional coastal racing:

August 19: The Memorial Hospice Regatta is a three-race series for PHRF Spinnaker and PHRF Genoa Only fleets. A Youth division will sail as many races as possible. The overall winner of the spinnaker fleet will earn a place in the National Hospice Regatta 2016.

August 20: The Rochester Race is a 4-10 mile coastal race for PHRF Spinnaker and Genoa Only boats with a rally start.

The Overall winner of the Rochester Race will be awarded the Commodore John Van Voorhis Trophy.

Rules: The racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020, and the PHRF-LO handicapping system. The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and Supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be on the official notice board located adjacent to slip 13 in the RYC Basin.

Classes: Divisions for PHRF rated spinnaker, PHRF rated Jib and Main / White Sails and Youth sailing (up to age 18). One Design classes will be assigned a PHRF rating by the OA consistent with PHRF-LO ODR ratings.

Entry Fees: The basic entry fee for PHRF Rated boats is \$100

The optional premium entry fee is \$250.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available on-line at myyc.org and www.rochesteryc.com/offshore/regattas/hospice and will be distributed in the competitor's handbook at check-in beginning on August 19, 2017 at RYC.

Courses: The courses to be sailed will include Windward-Leeward and Triangle courses for the Hospice Series, and a coastal course for the Rochester Race. Course descriptions and diagrams will be furnished in the sailing instructions.

Penalties: For violations of rules of Part II, the two-turns penalty will apply to the Hospice Race Series, and a scoring penalty will apply to the Rochester Race.

Scoring: Appendix A low-point scoring will be used as modified in the Sailing Instructions.

Prizes: Will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division, and overall.
