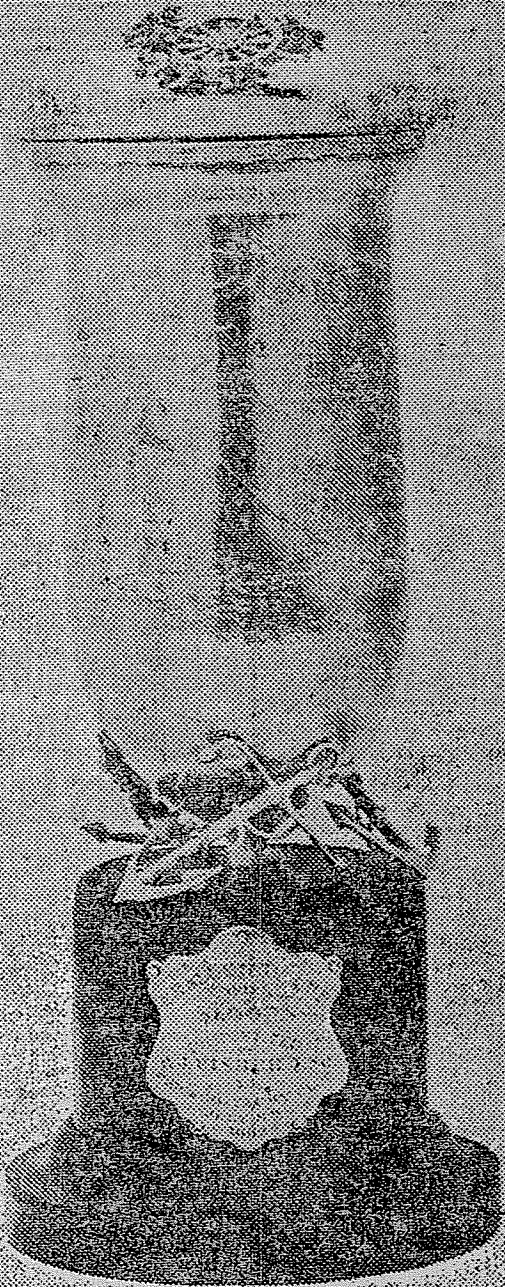


Rochester Sailors Seek It



Historic Fisher cup, oldest trophy on Lake Ontario which the Rochester Yacht Club hopes to regain in a series of races to be sailed at Toronto, September 7, 8 and 9, if a third race is necessary. The challenge from the local club, accepted by the Royal Canadian Yacht Club of Toronto last week names Class P boats.

The cup was first placed in competition on the Atlantic Coast in 1871 and was held for a time by Chicago, Cobourg and Belleville Yacht Clubs. It found its way into the Rochester Yacht Club's lockers when the Onward of Rochester defeated the Norah of Belleville in a northeast gale in Big Bay in 1892. The Royal Canadian's Zoraya took it back to Canada when she defeated the Rochester Yacht Club's Equinox in two straight races off Summerville in 1906.
