Five members of our fleet engaged in the Central N.Y. regatta, a three day series of frigid racing, held at the Ithaca Yacht Club. Cliff Baker in Stars'n II dismasted and withdrew. "Sherm" Farnham sailing "Vivace" with Miss Hargrave as crew placed second although tied Dr. Doran sailing "Turtle Star" in total points. "Peck" Farley took the third spot. The team trophy presented By Sam Smith to the Seneca Lake Fleet.

Howard Patterson completed his boat "Sisu" in time for son "Roger" to sail in the Labor Day Series before leaving for M.I.T. where he expects to engage in intercollegiate sailing competition.

Philip Tierney has now equipped his new boat with the modern light rig but has not disposed of his neat double cockpit arrangement. This conversion completes the change to the modern light rig for our entire fleet.

Cliff Baker after dismasting has equipped his boat "Stars'n II" with the single spreader rig in hopes of imitating the feats of "Rambunctious".

The club Championship, delayed by the "R" boat championship of the Great Lakes being sailed at Rochester, was noted for the exceptional strong winds and high seas and the crowning of co-champions. The series ended in a tie between "Bill" Nevin sailing "Emmy Lou" and "Peck" Farley sailing "Deuce". It is doubtful that the tie will be broken on account of the expected heavy weather and the reluctance of both skippers to decide their fate by the flip of a coin.
